

## Harley & Donna Rector Scholarship

Mr. Harley Rector was a longtime educator at Norfolk Public Schools and served in the role of a teacher, coach, or administrator for 32 years at the Norfolk Junior High. Prior to his career in Norfolk, he taught at Fullerton Public Schools and Tecumseh Public Schools. Harley Rector was also an active member of the Norfolk community serving on numerous boards and committees, in addition to two terms as the city's mayor.

Harley truly loved educating and coaching young adults and getting to know his students and all those around him. He was active in his community and believed in the value of being involved.

## **Selection Criteria:**

- 1. One written letter of recommendation from a NPS faculty/staff member is required. This letter of recommendation should address the student's leadership and civic involvement. The letter of recommendation and completed essay will serve as primary selection criteria.
- 2. In the event that two students seem equally qualified, preference should be given to the student pursuing a degree in education. All students, regardless of area of study, are encouraged to apply and area of study will only be used as secondary selection criteria if deemed necessary by the selection committee.
- 3. Must write a personal essay (see application).
- 4. Selection will be made by the NPSF Scholarship Committee.
