Differentiation Support: Help design choice assignments or tiered activities and/or assessment for your students

Data Charts: Collaboratively analyze formative assessment data to make instructional decisions

Demonstration Lesson: Model a lesson in your classroom or an alternate classroom while you observe.

Professional Development: Provide one-on-one training on the NPS Instructional Model, technology resources, and/or best practices

Reflection: Through conversation and observation, aid in your reflection of student learning in your room

Networking: Help you connect with other teachers within Norfolk Public Schools

Brainstorming Session: Collaboratively bounce innovative ideas off one another
