SCHOOL LUNCH

School lunch will offer a wide variety of choices for students.

All students have two entrée choices daily.

All meals include an entrée choice, a hot vegetable plus the unlimited Fruit & Veggie Bar, and milk choices.



PRESCHOOL SNACK

All preschool students will be offered a snack daily.

The snack is free to all enrolled preschoolers.

SCHOOL LUNCH ACCOUNTS

Enclosed is the District's Lunch Account Policy for the 24-25 School year. If a student has a negative balance, they may not charge seconds, or purchase from the ala cart menu. Families with a negative balance receive emailed statements or phone messages generated from the lunch software. Families with a total negative balance of \$-20.00 will be contacted by the administration. Students with negative \$20.00 balance will be served an alternate meal until the balance has been paid.

A Point of Sale (POS) software system is used for the school lunch program. Please note the following important information:

- Each student will have his/her own individual lunch number.
- If sending cash with a student, place in a sealed envelope, along with the student's name.
- We are not responsible for lost, unidentified, or stolen cash.
- Deposits should be turned in by 8 a.m. at the school.
- Deposits can be made anytime at our school website through Infinite Campus.

Lunch Account Deposits must be made before school starts. Because we receive an overwhelming amount of deposits the morning of the first day of school, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to input all deposits into accounts before the lunch period begins.

Applications for Free and Reduced-price meals must be received by Administration.

Applications can be picked-up at the District Administration Building, or are available at the school website on the "Food Service" page.

All students will be at Paid status on the first day of school, unless the Free & Reduced application has been received and approved prior to the first day of school.

DIET MODIFICATIONS

EXTRA ENTRÉE – EXTRA MILK

All students, at an extra cost, can purchase an additional entrée or milk offered as part of the school lunch program.

For example if a student wants a second entrée, or an additional entrée, like a slice of pizza, then the student will visit the cashier after seconds are announced. This will be charged to the student's account.

All students have an All You Can Eat Fruit and Veggie Bar and can have extra servings of these with no charge:

Canned Fruit

Fresh Fruit

Vegetables

Lettuce

If a student is free or reduced they may receive one entrée with their meal but they must have money in their account to purchase any extra entrees.

Please feel free to join your child for a meal any day. The cost for an adult/guest breakfast is \$2.80 and an adult/guest lunch is \$4.80.
